> What can these records tell me?

The Catholic parish registers were recorded in either English or Latin. Latin was the official language of the Catholic Church until the 1960s. Individuals' names were often Latinized, for example, the name Patrick will appear as Patricius. Below we have provided some Latin translations to help you read the parish records.

The type of record will determine what you can discover about your ancestor.

Record types

Baptism

The baptism records will provide you with the name of the person who was baptised, the date of the baptism, where the baptism took place, and the name of the individual's parents. Each register will also show the individual's address, the parish, and the diocese.

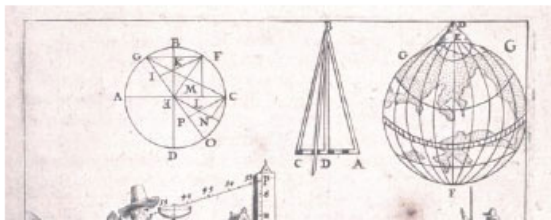

The armies of the English Commonwealth, commanded by Oliver Cromwell, emerged victorious and immediately undertook an ambitious project of social engineering, underpinned by a massive transfer in landownership from Irish Catholics to English Protestants. For this to happen, the land had to be accurately surveyed and mapped, a task overseen by the surgeon-general of the English army, William Petty.

The Down Survey of Ireland

Taken in the years 1656-1658, the Down Survey of Ireland is the first ever detailed land survey on a national scale anywhere in the world. The survey sought to measure all the land to be forfeited by the Catholic Irish in order to facilitate its redistribution to Merchant Adventurers and English soldiers. Copies of these maps have survived in dozens of

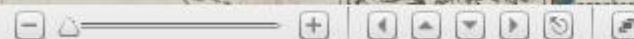

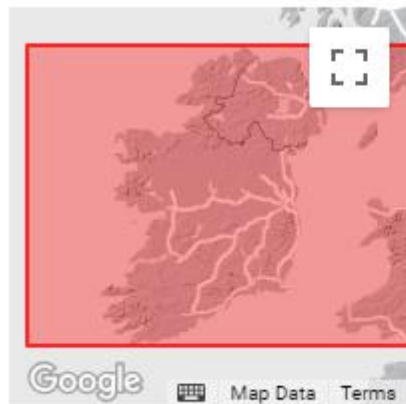

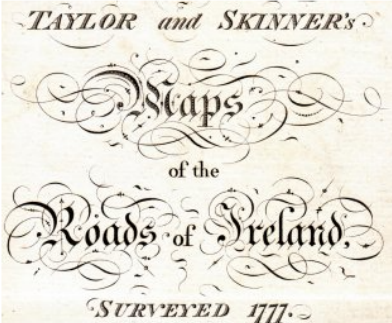

All the maps have been scanned and available in a pan and zoom control, similar to google maps, to show each map in detail, with linked coordinates to key locations such as towns, cross referenced on a Google map.

Details of each step in a route may be viewed in sequence with overall locations mapped on Google maps. The placename index used for searches contains just over 550 distinct entries. Alternate names and variations can be used in searches.

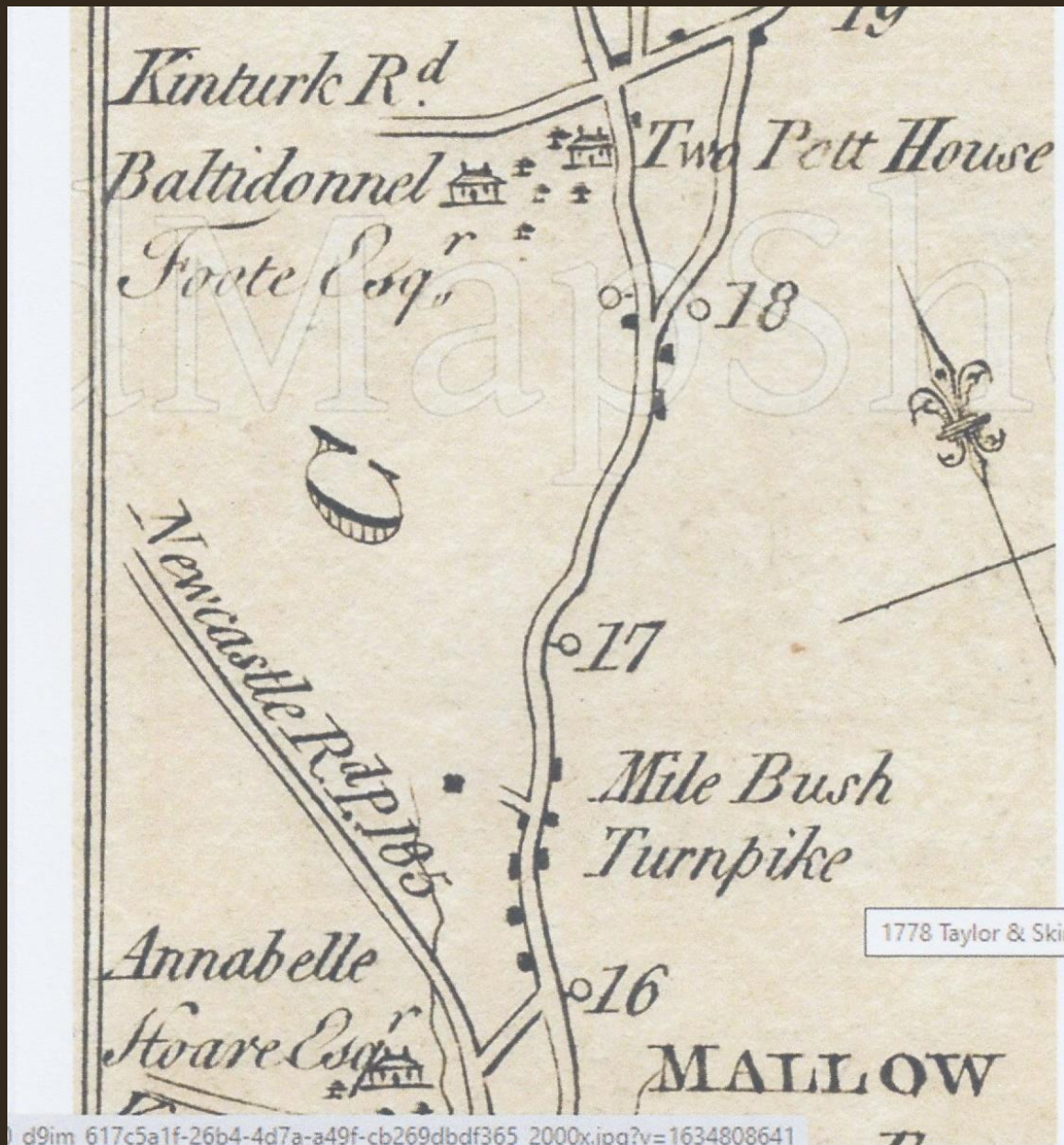

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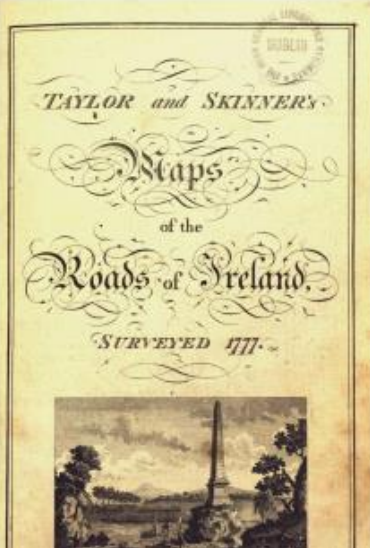

George Taylor and Andrew Skinner were surveyors who had already surveyed the roads of Scotland and the postroad from London to Bath. In 1776, they sought funding from Ireland's noblemen and gentlemen in order to map the roads of Ireland. They succeeded in raising over £2,000 which paid for their survey costs, two additional surveyors and sixteen assistants, the engraving and the printing costs. They began their survey in February 1777 and completed it by the end of the year.

We have evidence from other writers at the time about the condition of the roads and the quality of existing maps in Ireland. Dr. Richard Twiss published his *Tour in Ireland* in the same year, complaining of the condition of the roads and the lack of accuracy of the maps. Arthur Young praised the roads and the maps. The real state of Irish roads at the time would have been good for the main commercial and the leisure destinations. Maps on the other hand, would have been county-based, as in Bernard Scale's *Hibernian Atlas*, published in 1776, or route guides of varying accuracy.

Taylor and Skinner's *Maps of the Roads of Ireland* was published in two editions, 1777 and 1782. The 1782 edition contains one extra plate, revised lists of noblemen and gentlemen and some amendments to placenames.

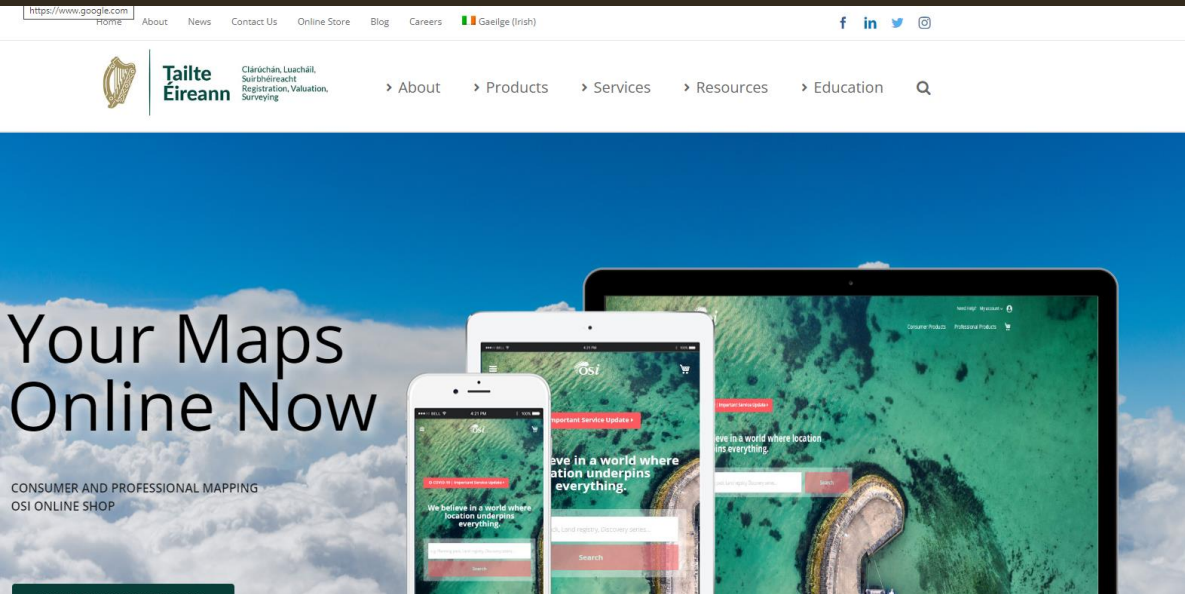

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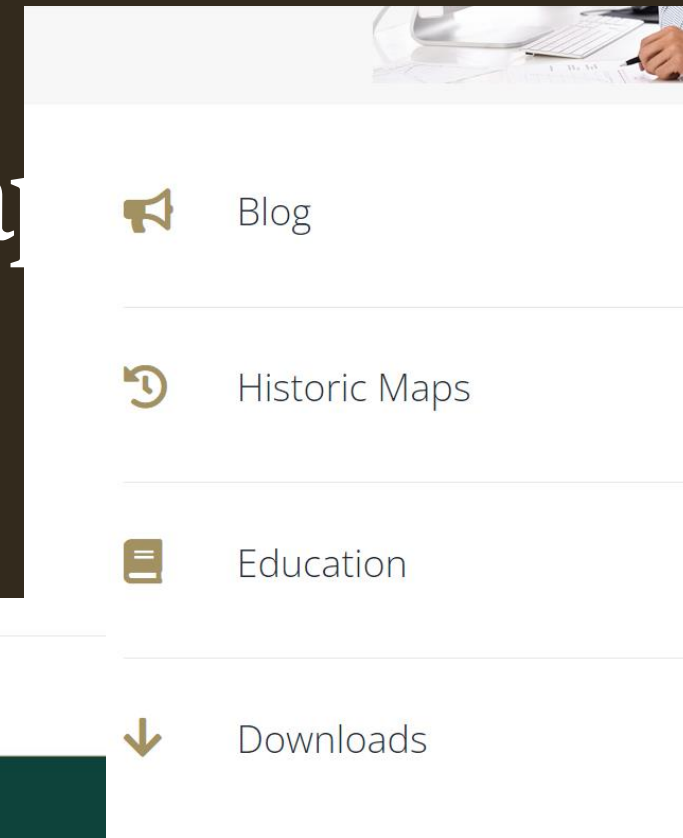
A look back in time
